Mentoring Program: Serve as a mentor to a student and help him/her stay on the right path. Commitment is for 10 months, approximately 5 hours per month during lunch and recess time (11:45-1:30pm)

Administrative Support: Help support the Haley through administrative duties including data analysis, marketing, website development, fundraising, library coordination and school yard maintenance throughout the school year. Times are flexible based on your schedule.

Career Day “Read Around the Haley”: Our annual Career Day event expose Haley students to a variety of professional opportunities and what it takes to achieve them. We seek individuals from a variety of professions and backgrounds to inspire, advise and connect with our students at this one day event in the spring.

Special Projects: Students at the Haley engage in amazing projects throughout the year including building boats from scratch, creating mechanical robots, gardening and selling produce, sailing on the Boston Harbor and exploring our local neighborhoods.
